### GSA Educates Sunyani SHS Students on its Activities

The Ghana Standards Authority (GSA), represented by the Bono Regional Office, made a presentation on its activities to students at the Sunyani Senior High School (SUSEC) on Saturday, February 10, 2024.

The aim of the presentation was to enlighten the students on the significance of Standards, Certification, and Conformity Assessment. Mr. Thomas Obour, the Senior House Master of the School, was among the attendees.

During the session, the GSA elaborated its mandate as the National Standards and Conformity Assessment Body. Students were encouraged to look out for the GSA Certification Mark when making purchases, and they were provided with a

comprehensive overview of the procedures involved in product certification.

Emphasis was placed on the advantages of adhering to standards and securing certification for products. Additionally, the presentation addressed processes such as destination inspection and labelling requirements (LI 1541).

Given the predominant farming nature of the region, special attention was given to verifying all trading scales using green (passed) and red (failed) stickers, particularly during the cashew season.

Students were encouraged to disseminate knowledge about these stickers to their families.
