

UNIDO Donates Testing Equipment to GSA to Support Rice Quality Project

On Monday July 7, 2025, the United Nations Industrial Development Organisation (UNIDO), donated specialised testing equipment to the GSA in support of its rice quality improvement project.

Mr. David Darko, a representative from UNIDO, expressed his organisation's appreciation for the ongoing collaboration with GSA and stressed that the equipment will help maintain and enhance the quality and standard of locally produced rice.

He further noted that GSA is the first institution to receive
